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**Pesticide Safety Training Requirements:** this class is intended for anyone who has unlicensed pesticide applicators (pesticide handlers) working under their supervision and is required to provide them training. It will go into detail about the training that is required to be given to pesticide handlers by the Federal Worker Protection Standard (WPS) and the California Code of Regulations (CCR). We will also talk about adult learning principles and how to tailor your training towards adults to maximize their learning.

**Overview of CA Respirator Requirements:** this class is intended for anyone who applies pesticides that require the use of a respirator, and anyone who supervises and/or employes respirator users. It will go into details about what is required by the CA Respirator Regulations (3 CCR Section 6739), including: when to wear a respirator, how to choose a respirator, what training must be given to respirator users, fit tests and fit checks.

**Taught by Lisa Blecker of the University of California, Statewide IPM Program**

Working for the University of California as the Pesticide Safety Education Coordinator for the Statewide IPM Program Lisa Blecker delivers training for those that train field workers and pesticide handlers throughout the state and is developing pre-license training and continuing education units for licensed pesticide applicators.

Having over 10 years of experience, she also manages the revision of study guides for those taking their commercial applicator exams and has worked with National Association of State Departments of Agriculture Research Foundation (NASDARF) to co-write the National Soil Fumigation Manual.
