PAYMENT INFORMATION FOR ADULT VOLUNTEERS

New Volunteers

All requirements must have been completed by December 1, 2023 to have your enrollment fees paid and Live Scan reimbursed by the Butte 4-H County Council.

Returning Volunteers

Enrollment fees will be paid by the Butte 4-H County Council if all requirements are completed by October 19, 2023. Those that have not completed the requirements can pay \$36.00 by credit card or \$35.00 by check payable to UC Regents and mailed to our Office.

PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR YOUTH

- Credit Card- \$64.00 per youth. Payment will be posted usually by the next business day. (**This is the fastest way**) Link: <https://surveys.ucanr.edu/survey.cfm?surveynumber=41302>
- Cash- Give \$62.00 per youth to your Club Leader, receive a receipt, and the club will send the payment into the UCCE/4-H Office.
- Check- Write a \$62.00 per youth check made payable to UC Regents. Mail or drop off at UCCE/4-H Office; 5 County Center Drive; Oroville, CA 95965. Make sure you include names of all youths you are paying for.

You must complete the Volunteer Interest Survey first.

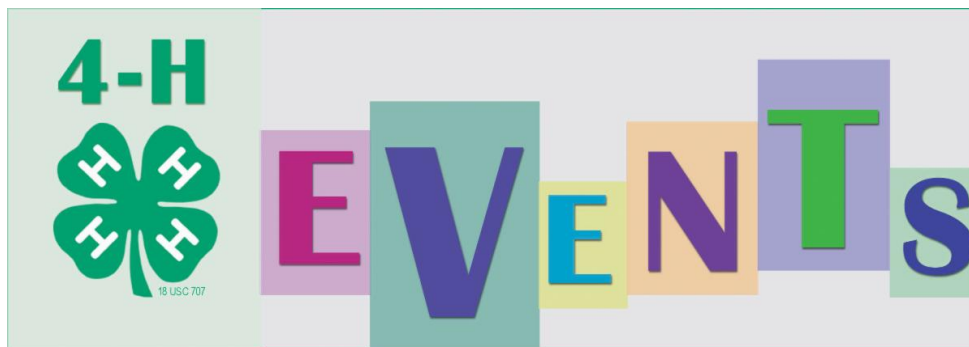
Once we review your survey, we will send you the correct Live Scan form, Live

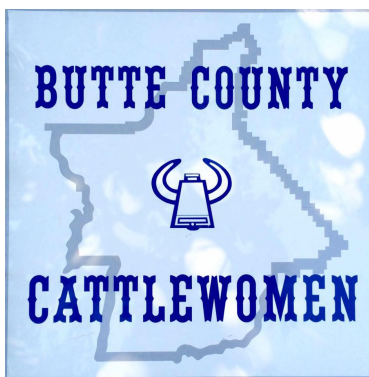
